SUMMARY

The Faith Students Discipleship Director assists the Faith Students Director in creating, developing, overseeing, and implementing spiritual development opportunities for middle school and high school students at Faith Church.

- Creates and facilitates relevant, challenging, biblical curriculum for both large and small groups, including leading bible studies and other growth opportunities
- Participates in other events, activities, and experiences for students
- Establishes and cultivates appropriate relationships with students for the purpose of church connection and spiritual development, including spending time with students
- Connects, engages, and partners with parents, e.g., provides resources for parents
- Creates and oversees environments, including maintaining safety and promoting spirituality – an engaging environment where students feel loved, known, and safe
- Assists the Faith Students Director in recruiting, training, developing, shepherding, and leading Faith Students volunteers, including building and implementing a facilitators program

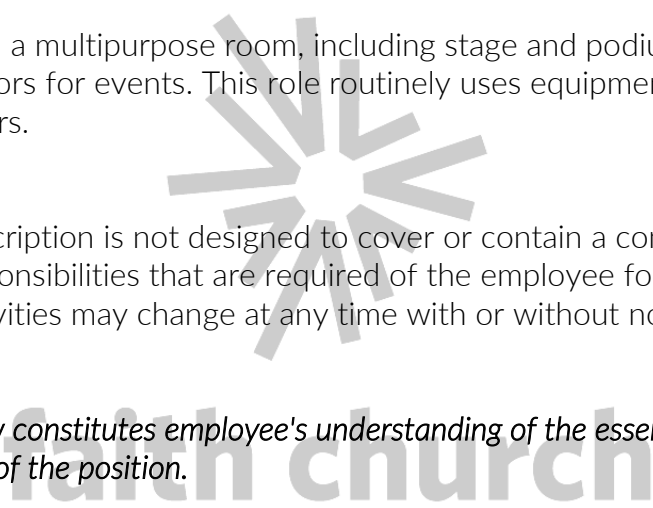
