

Sermon Title: The God of our Past, Present, and Future

Sermon Text: John 2:1-11

Date: January 28, 2024

Reread John 2:1-11 together as a group.

1. Reflect on a time when you had to trust someone or something in a significant way, like trusting an airplane or a pilot. How did that experience deepen your understanding of trust?
2. Keeping in mind the cultural background described in the sermon, discuss how this wedding miracle showcases Jesus' generosity and power. (For a similar demonstration, see Mark 6:30-44.) How does Jesus' character, as revealed in these miracles, impact our understanding of His trustworthiness?
3. In the group, share a personal testimony or experience where trusting Jesus had a significant impact on your life. How did it shape your understanding of His character and reliability?
4. Take a moment to reflect on areas of your past where you may need forgiveness or cleansing. How can trusting Jesus in these areas bring about transformation in your life?
5. Are there current decisions or challenges you are facing where you need guidance from Jesus? How can actively trusting Him influence your choices in these situations?
6. Considering the "Next Steps Pathway" mentioned in the sermon (Worship, Community, Outreach, Serving), which lane do you feel prompted to explore or deepen in your journey of following Jesus? Why?
7. When thinking about your future, what fears or uncertainties do you have? How can trusting Jesus, based on His character and past provisions, bring assurance and peace to those concerns?
