

Sermon Title: Walk in the Spirit

Sermon Text: Romans 7:1-25

Date: June 2, 2024

Read Romans 7:1-25 together.

1. Paul observes, "I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, 'You shall not covet'" (see verse 7). In what ways has the Bible helped you recognize something as a sin that you might otherwise not give a second thought?
2. Paul describes a struggle between his desire to do good and the sin living in him (see verses 15-20). Can you relate to this internal conflict? Share an example from your own life.
3. Discuss the statement: "Focusing on not sinning will not change you. Focusing on walking by the power of the Spirit will transform you." How does this shift in focus impact your approach to overcoming sin?
4. The sermon suggests being honest about your struggle with sin. What are some practical steps you can take to share your struggles with a trusted friend or group?
5. The sermon mentions that sanctification is a process. Share a moment when you experienced significant spiritual growth. What factors contributed to that growth?
