Sermon Text: Proverbs 30:7-9

1. Looking back at different stages of your life, what role has money played for you? Is it tied to a sense of security, anxiety, freedom, frustration, or something else?

2. Read Exodus 16:9-31 and Proverbs 30:8. What does Agur have in mind when he prays for 'daily bread'? What is he asking God for?

3. As Agur prays about his finances, he asks to be kept away from falsehood and lies. As a Christian in the marketplace, have you ever been around dishonest practices or been asked to act dishonestly? How did you navigate that situation?

4. Read Proverbs 30:9.
 - I. What are some ways we might dishonour God when we have more than we need? Have you ever experienced that temptation?

 - II. What are some ways we might dishonour the name of God when we don't have enough? Have you ever experienced that temptation?

5. Read Deuteronomy 8:17-18. How does God challenge the ideas that we don't need Him and that He won't provide for us?

6. On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate your current financial health? After hearing this week's sermon, is there an area you would like to grow in?
